

This chronology aims to provide a cursory overview of lcograda/lcoD's history, but for most part, does not delve into the finer details or claims to be representative of the complete and rich details of the organisation's historical legacy.

A diversity of sources have been consulted including the contributions by individuals, material available in the public domain, anecdotal contributions by people who have been closely involved in organising and/or managing lcograda/ ICoD initiatives, historical documents, vast numbers of photographs, official publications, news releases, magazine articles, books and other sources published over the past 60+ years. The accuracy of some entries spanning from 1962 to 1999 have not been verified against official documents contained in the Icograda Archive, which is held at the University of Brighton. A substantial portion of the Archive's vast holdings is currently digitised, yet the bulk of the material is not yet available online.

Discrepancies of dates occur in instances where proposals were presented and Board decisions were made and/or initiatives implemented before official ratification by General Assemblies (when required) in non-General Assembly years. In these instances, only the dates of ratification are mentioned. Not listed in this chronology are Executive Board Meetings hosted in locations around the globe, endorsements of thousands of design events, as well as some Achievement and Excellence Awards presented in the first ±40 years.

- Peter Kneebone proposes the idea to establish an international organisation for graphic design.
- Willy de Majo gets involved and together with a small team, develops a blueprint for the organisation's founding.
- The Society of Industrial Artists establishes a working group to promote the creation of an organisation to represent professional graphic design associations throughout the world.

Speakers from 24 Members organisations representing 17 countries explore the potential to collaborate on four key topics: National Design Policy, Communicating the Value of Design, Accreditation/Certification, and Curriculum Development.
- On 20 November the Council announces that the management of the Indigenous Design Network (INDIGO) is transferred to ico-D Member, Deakin University, under the supervision of Former ico-D President, Russell Kennedy.
- ico-D announces the publication of Communication Design: Interdisciplinary and Graphic Design Research Volume 3(2).

2017

- The 2017 World Design Day theme is Start Young. Celebrations consists of a programme spanning five continents, in five languages, aimed at introducing design concepts to kids through bespoke educational workshops.
- The Council hosts the Regional Meeting Latin America, held at Estación Mapocho in Santiago (Chile) on 19-20 January to actively engage with Members and the Latin American (LATAM) design community.
- ICoD pilots a Design Education Lab, partnering ico-D Member organisations in China and abroad for a student exchange programme geared to establish collaboration.
- ico-D announces the publication of Communication Design: Interdisciplinary and Graphic Design Research Volume 4 (1+2).
- The ico-D Board participates in a seminar titled *The Future of Design* on 18
 May 2017 in Jakarta, Indonesia. The event coincides with design workshops and a Board Meeting.
- In October the Council holds a series of meetings culminating in the first ever World Design Summit in Montréal, Canada.
- The launch of the International Indigenous Design Charter takes place at the World Design Summit. It is a self-regulated, best practice guide that supports existing policies, procedures and protocols to ensure the rights of Indigenous stakeholders.
- Ico-D host a Platform Meeting on 13-14 October in Montréal, Canada, under the theme, *Design is Global*. The programme is designed to permit overlap between Professional, Promotional and Educational Members on topics including: accreditation/certification, indigenous design heritage, blueprints for designers' lifelong learning, and national design policies.
- The Council's 27th General Assembly is held on 15-16 October in Montréal,
 Canada.
- The 2017 ICoD Presidents Award recipients are Kathryn Moore, President of IFLA, and Regitze Marianne Hess.
- The Council holds its first ever meeting of Design Weeks, Design Cities and
 Design Museums on 21 October at the Montréal Museum of Fine Arts. A pilot
 project targeting a small cross-section of non-member organisations, bringing
 together representatives of 15 entities from ten different countries.
- On 24 October, the Montréal Design Declaration is signed by 18 international organisations, representing upwards of a million design practitioners. The declaration is an historic milestone, as for the first time, international

organisations representing designers, architects, city/town planners and landscape architects come together to advocate for the potential of design to address important challenges facing humanity and issue a joint call to action.

- ico-D hosts a Regional Meeting for the members of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) countries on 5-6 February in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.
- The 2018 World Design Day theme is Kids can too! It builds upon the WDD workshops that transpired in 2017.
- ico-D hosts a Platform Meeting on 18-20 September in Beijing, China, under the theme *Design is Changing* as an acknowledgement that our world is changing at a rapid pace and that our profession has an important role to play in the future.
- The Council's Annual General Meeting takes place on 19 September in Beijing, China.
- The second meeting of Design Weeks, Design Cities and Design Museums is held on 21-22 September in Beijing, China, in partnership with Beijing Design Week. The Meeting brings together representatives of 17 entities from 14
- ico-D announces the publication of Communication Design: Interdisciplinary and Graphic Design Research Volume 5 (1+2).

- The 2019 World Design Day theme is Women in design.
- In anticipation of a future Design Declaration Summit, a Pre-Summit Meeting
 is held in Saint-Étienne, France, on 03-05 April, hosted by the Saint-Étienne
 Design Biennale. More than 40 organisations participate in sessions on
 metrics and collecting data, design policy and design education and research.
- The third iteration of the meeting of Design Weeks, Design Cities and Design Museums is held on 10-11 May in Graz, Austria. The meeting attracts 30 representatives of 17 entities from 13 different countries.
- The Council holds a Regional Meeting of European Members on 20-21 June in Matosinhos, Portugal.

- The Council's 28th General Assembly is held on 29 November in tandem with the ico-D Platform Meeting on 1 December in Vancouver, Canada. The Meeting theme is *Design is Professional*.
- The 2019 ico-D President's Award recipient is Prof. Min Wang from China.
- The ico-D Achievement Award recipients are Bob Hambly, Hélène Godin,
 Hanno Ehses, and Deborah Shackleton, all from Canada.
- The Council releases two newly updated Design Awards and Competitions
 Best Practice Papers.

2020

- In February, the Board participates in an event titled *Our Time is Now*, held in Johannesburg, South Africa, hosted by the African Institute of the Interior Design Professions (IID). The Board meets with local design representatives and participates in activities with regional designers to discuss design perspectives in Africa.
- Ico-D holds its last in-person Board Meeting in February in Johannesburg,
 South Africa, as a global pandemic of severe acute respiratory syndrome
 (SARS-CoV-2) shuts down world travel for many months.
- On 12 March ico-D announces its initial response to the COVID-19 pandemic crisis. The protocols include steps to reschedule events and converting some to virtual platforms, re-organise Secretariat resources, reducing and temporarily halting representative travel, and refocusing energies to develop relevant future projects. As a response to the pandemic, the Council's Meetings are moved to a virtual format from 2020 to 2022. The Council holds 24 virtual meetings on various topics from pandemic response to professional standards and the future of design.
- World Design Day is renamed International Design Day and the theme for 2020 is *Be Professional!* and is celebrated virtually due to Covid-19 restrictions.
- The acronym for the International Council of Design is officially changed from ico-D to ICoD to make it hash-tag-able on social media, since hyphens cannot be used in tags.
- In August, the Council launches a revision of its English version of its Professional Code of Conduct for Designers.

- The theme for 2021 International Design Day is Design for each and all!
- The Board announces that the 29th General Assembly is postponed by a year due to Covid-19 travel restrictions. This extends this Board's term from two to three years.
- On 29 June, ICoD participates in Afrocentric Design: Practice and Curriculum,
 Afrika Design Education Conference, organised by the Pan Afrikan Design
 Institute (PADI). The conference explores possible futures for design
 education to reflect and share what Afrocentric design means.
- The Professional Code of Conduct for Designers is translated into Spanish.



ICoD introduces of the *Polemics* section on its website as a dedicated space to explore discourse and thought on the contemporary practice of design.

- The Special Meetings of Design Weeks, Festivals and Biennials, Design Museums, Design Cities, Design Awards (and more) is renamed as the Iridescent Network, a para-Member network like the International Design Media Network (IDMN).
- The theme for 2022 International Design Day is Suspended in Transition. It is celebrated via four Instagram Lives casts to reflect on and discuss the shifting state of contemporary design in different regions.
- In response to the continuous rise of speculative (spec) competitions, the
 Council creates a video primer outlining what defines a spec competition and why it believes them to be exploitative and unfair.
- On 15 October, representatives from 12 Member organisations from 11
 countries gather in Kaunas, Lithuania, for the Council's first in-person Platform
 Meeting since the global Covid-19 pandemic. The 2022 Platform Meeting
 theme, *Design is possibility*, explores the endless potential design must adapt
 to a changing world.
- ICoD hosts is 29th General Assembly on 16 October in Kaunas, Lithuania.
- Gediminas Lašas, Audrius Klimas and Aušra Lisauskienė are the recipients of the 2022 ICoD Achievement Awards.
- The 2022 ICoD Education Award recipient is Elita Lam from Hong Kong,
 China.

- Ana Masut resigns as the Council's Director General. The Secretariat is restructured and Eva Bulas is appointed as ICoD's General Manager (February).
- The ICoD Secretariat continues to operate remotely since closing its physical office in August 2020, with all daily operations and tasks being handled primarily online.
- International Design Day theme for 2023 is *Peace. Love. Design!* The theme not only marks the Council's 60th Anniversary but also takes its cue from the activism of the 1960s, encouraging designers worldwide to explore issues of environmentalism, social equity, collective movements and radical change.
- Former ICoD Managing Director Ana Masut is awarded Lifetime Friend status for her foundational work at the International Council of Design.
- The Professional Code of Conduct for Designers is translated in Turkish and is now available in Arabic, English, Japanese, Polish, Spanish, Lithuanian and Turkish.
- On 27 April, the ICoD celebrates its 60th anniversary of its founding and collaborates with the University of Brighton Archives to spotlight the Icograda Archive and the organisation's founding history by sharing photos and historical details on social media.
- Marnie Guglielmi-Vitullo is appointed as ICoD's General Manager (September)
- In response to designers affected by the war in Ukraine, the Council launched a resource page, created by European ICoD Members, to provide resources and guidance to assist Ukrainian designers displaced by the war.
- ICoD revitalises its existing global collaboration platform by rebranding it as
 the Iridescent Network to highlight its importance as a space for fostering
 collaboration and innovation among designers worldwide.

THE EVOLUTION OF THE ORGANISATION: THE NEXT 10 YEARS, 2023 TO CURRENT



- In February the TASA-ICoD International Design Education Laboratory
 (EduLab) is established through an agreement between the Council and
 Tsinghua University, China, providing students and educators opportunities to
 experiment and delve into the social, economic, cultural, and environmental
 challenges anticipated by 2050.
- The Professional Code of Conduct for Designers is translated in Portuguese
 its seventh translation. These translations have significantly broadened the reach of ICoD's ethical guidelines, promoting responsible design practices in regions with diverse linguistic backgrounds and reinforcing the Council's dedication to inclusivity.
- ICoD celebrates International Design Day 2024 with the theme *Is it kind?* with activities led by the Lithuanian Design Association (LDA). The theme questions the way design could transform current systems into possibilities to design with kindness, ensuring a kinder future for all. On 27 April 2024, LDA hosts an in-person workshop and conference in Vilnius, Lithuania. The conference stream online on the ICoD YouTube Channel invite speakers from outside of the design profession to provide their take on building kindness into design practice.
- From 17-18 October ICoD hosts an ICoD Education Platform Meeting and first TASA-ICoD International Conference on *Evolving Design Education Curricula*, in Qingdao, China.
- During the Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) on 19 October 2024, Members approved governance revisions to the Articles of Incorporation of the Council. The number of Board members elected by the Assembly is reduced from 10 to 5 individuals. The position of President-Elect is eliminated, and the designation 'Vice President' is replaced with 'Board Member'. The former term 'co-option' is replaced with appointment of 'non-executive' Board positions. Physical Board Meetings can now also be alternated with virtual meetings.
- The 30th General Assembly of the Council takes place on 19 October at Tsinghua (Qingdao) Academy of Arts and Science Innovation Research (TASA), a research campus of ICoD Member Tsinghua University, in Qingdao, China. Voting members of the Council passes a number of amendments to the Articles and Bylaws to align with the EGM's decisions from the previous day, and elects its 30th Executive Board, among others.

- During the 2022-2024 term the Council's membership number accounted for 85 Members (Professional, Promotional, Education and Corresponding Entities) from 45 countries.

- Launch of the ICoD Industry Friends programme, a non-voting Member category, seeking like-minded organisations, government agencies, foundations, and ethical businesses that share our ideals, values, and objectives.
- ICoD celebrates International Design Day 2025 with the theme *Outlandish optimism*, with activities led by the Polish Association of Designers.
- ICoD Regional Meeting Europe, themed *The Next Code of Conduct*, takes place in Ljubljana on 6 June 2025, co-organised with the Brumen Foundation and Design Federation OÜ, and hosted in partnership with the European Design Festival. The RM agenda focussed on setting standards for the ICoD Code of Conduct and AI to address the role of design in understanding the complex relationships between AI and humans, the environment, cities and all forms of life. The RM includes a workshop and publication of *The Cards of Conduct*, published as an official ICoD product.
- ICoD expands its international impact through a growing roster of Endorsed
 Events and the Member Event Seal programme. The ICoD Event seal
 confirms that the body organising the event has pledged to follow international
 standards for best practice.
- In October the Board publishes a call for Expressions of Interest to host the
 ICoD Sectretariat in a new location for a period of 10 years.
